

University of Maryland Children's Searching Studies CHILD INTERVIEW SCRIPT



REMINDER: DON'T INITIATE THE WORD "GOOGLE" BEFORE QUESTION 20.

[If child did not already verbally consent to recording] Your Mom/Dad said it was ok to video record our interview, but we can record just our voices or turn off the camera if it bothers you. Is the camera ok?

Thanks for taking the time to talk to us today! We're really excited that you are helping us out. We want to know more about how you look for information using the computer. This isn't a test – there are no right or wrong answers - and the information you share with us will be used to help us understand how children search. If you want to stop or take a break at any time while we're talking, just let me know, and we can skip questions if you don't want to answer them. Do you have any questions before we start?

Don't wait until the next day!] Examples: Physical movements; technical computer or Internet issues; other people in the home during interview; conversations occurring off-camera; location of the interview within the home; demeanor of participant; which researchers were present; time of day and day of week of interview; participant's activities preceding and following interview; etc.
